







NOTICE OF RACE International <u>14</u> Class World Championships July 29th-August 9th 2024

The notation [NP] in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule and the protest committee may refuse to hold a hearing. This changes RRS 60.1(a) and 63.1.

The notation [SP] in a rule means that a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee or technical committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty may be applied by the protest committee with a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1.

1. RULES

- 1.1 [Individuals only] The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 [Team Racing only] The event is governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including Appendix D, Team Racing Rules.
- 1.3 [Team Racing only] Races will not be umpired, RRS D2 does not apply.
- 1.4 Following national authority prescriptions apply:
- 1.4.1 The "Normativa FIV per l'Attività Sportiva Nazionale" has to be considered as a "rule".
- 1.4.2 According to "Norme di navigazione sul Lago di Garda" all public transportation ships are right of way while in service on the lake.
- 1.5 RRS 90.3 (e) will apply
- 1.6 Competitors shall comply with RRS 40.1 at all times while afloat. The personal floatation device (PFD) shall at least fulfil the requirements of ISO 12402-5 or an equivalent standardization. Inflatable buoyancy vests are not permitted.
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS and NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

3. [NP] ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to all boats of the International <u>14</u> Class.
- 3.2 [Team Racing only] Teams may consist of up to five boats, of which no more than four may compete in each race.
- 3.3 [Individuals only] The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:
- 3.4 Each competitor shall be member of his national International <u>14</u> class association where one exists.
- 3.5 All competitors (skipper and crew) must be members of a club affiliated with a national authority of World Sailing (RRS 75).
- 3.6 Italian competitors must have a valid FIV card including a valid health certificate.

- 3.7 The competitor may be asked to present the following documents:
 - Confirmation of club membership or license
 - Measurement Certificate or Certificate of Conformity.
 - Copy of the third-party liability insurance (€ 1.500.000,00)
- 3.8 [Team Racing only] Teams may enter the event by sending the completed entry form in pdfformat to <u>info@circolovelatorbole.com</u>. The form can be downloaded from the notice board.
- 3.9 [Individuals only] Eligible boats may enter the event by registering online at the <u>https://www.circolovelatorbole.com/it/regatta/detail/276</u>
- 3.10 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat/team shall complete all registration requirements and pay the entry fees until **July 12th 2024.**
- 3.11 Late Entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the organizing authority until **July 20th 2024**.

4. ENTRY FEES

5. [DP] ADVERTISING

- 5.1 Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the organizing authority as per WS regulation 20.
- 5.2 [NP] Competitors aboard the boats ranked first, second and third in the series at the beginning of each racing day, will be asked to wear yellow, blue and red bibs respectively on a voluntary basis while racing.
- 5.3 It is prohibited to distribute and display advertising material both in the area of the shore facilities and jetties or to fix such material separately on the boats and harbor facilities, unless prior permission has been given by the organizing authority.

- 6.2 [Team Racing only] The event will consist of a round-robin series stage followed by a knockout stage. Details will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.3 [Individuals only] The event will consist of 7 races with one race per day scheduled. If a race is abandoned, it may be re-sailed on the same day
- 6.4 First Warning signal will be at 13.00 on August 2nd. If no notice is posted on the official notice board, the warning signal of the previous day will stay in force).
- 6.5 No Warning signal will be made after 13.00 on the last day.
- 6.6 In case of delay in the program a 2nd race can be sailed in one day of the event with a previous notice to competitors.

7. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1 Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 [DP] Boats shall be available for equipment inspection during the times stated in NoR 6.1. During the scheduled time for equipment inspection and event measurement no initial (first) measurements will be carried out.
- 7.3 A list of equipment that will be inspected or measured will be published on notice board prior to the event.
- 7.4 Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 from time at which the equipment inspection is completed until the end of the event.
- 7.5 Boats may be inspected at any time.

8. VENUE

- 8.1 The event will be hosted at the grounds of the Circolo Vela Torbole.
- 8.2 The race office will be located on the first floor of the Circolo Vela Torbole clubhouse, Lungolago Conca d'Oro 12 38069 Torbole sul Garda Tel. +39.0464.506240.
- 8.3 Addendum "Racing area" shows the location of the racing area in the waters of North Garda lake.
- 8.4 [NP][DP] The boat park is open from July 28th to 9 August 9th. Contact Circolo Vela Torbole for training options outside this period or earlier delivery of containers/trailers. Training will be possible with be permission of the organizing authority. However, those training options are limited and require prior permission of the organizing authority.

9. COURSES

- 9.1 [Team Racing only] The courses will be short 'digital N' type or windward/leeward. Details will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2 [Individuals only] The courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 [Team Racing only] The right of appeal from a protest committee decision is denied as provided in RRS 70.5(a).
- 10.2 [Individuals only] RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.3 [Individuals only] International jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91(b). The right of appeal from an international jury decision is denied as provided in RRS 70.5.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 Individuals only:
- 11.1.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.1.2 a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

- 11.2 Team Racing only: The event will be scored in in accordance with RRS D4. Details will be defined in the Sailing Instructions as required by RRS D4.2(a).
- 11.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

12. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 12.1 All support persons shall be accredited by filling in the registration form available online and presenting the following documents upon arrival: insurance of the vehicle, personal document, boat licence if required and dinghy document, declaration and acceptance of the "rules for support personnel and assistance boats" described in the Sailing Instructions and the names of the accompanied Competitors.
- 12.2 Support persons and support person vessels shall comply with local legislation and 'Event Support Team Regulations' that will be published on the notice board.
- 12.3 Accredited support personnel shall be subject to the technical and disciplinary directives of the CoR and the Jury, who may act under rule 64.5 in the event of an infringement.

13. [DP] BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park.

14. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 14.1 By entering the event, each competitor and his/her support persons automatically grant to the organizing authority, the international and national International 14 Class Associations, and their sponsors the absolute right, authority and permission in perpetuity to make, use, distribute and show in any media, from time to time at their discretion, any images, audio and audio visual recordings, biographical information, reproductions (and to make edits and adaptations of the same) of competitors and/or their boat/s during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 14.2 [NP][DP] Competitors may be required to be available for interviews at the event.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in

the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

16. [DP][NP] ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY:

16.1 Recalling the Basic Principle that states: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any negative environmental impact of the sport of sailing", it is recommended that the utmost attention be paid to environmental protection in all moments accompanying the practice of the sport of sailing before, during and after the event. In particular, attention is drawn to RRS 47 -Trash Disposal.

17. INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.500.000 (or the equivalent) per incident. It is the competitors' sole responsibility to ensure that the insurance is current, valid and adequate.

18. PRIZES

- 18.1 [Individuals only] Prizes will be awarded to skipper and crew of the ten highest ranked boats in the overall scoring.
- 18.2 [Team Racing only] Prizes will be awarded to skipper and crew of boats in the three highest ranked boats in the overall scoring.
- 18.3 Perpetual trophies:
- 18.3.1 First Place: The International <u>14</u> World Championship Trophy
- 18.3.2 Winner of the First Race: The Chris Benedict Trophy
- 18.3.3 First female competitor: The Glass Doll Trophy
- 18.3.4 First competitor over the age of 50 after the first day of the event: The Wind-Masters Trophy
- 18.3.5 In keeping with tradition, no perpetual trophy will be awarded for the Team Racing event.
- 18.3.6 [NP] The winner of a perpetual trophy shall keep it in his or her safe custody and return it to the venue of the next world championships at his own expenses no later than two weeks prior to this event. The winner shall be responsible for any damage or loss. It is therefore recommended to cover this risk by adequate insurance.
- 18.4 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority and/or the International <u>14</u> Class Association.
- 18.5 Prizes not claimed at the prize giving ceremony will remain with the organizing authority.
